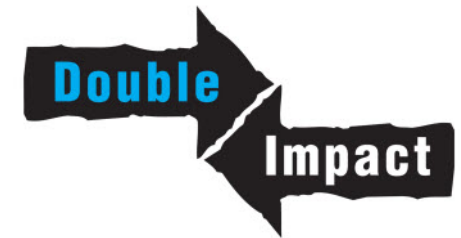

Individual Support

At your first appointment you will get to meet your Drug & Alcohol Worker. Your worker will discuss with you your aims and together you will create a plan of support.

Your plan may include attending other Double Impact groups or services. But, if you just want individual support that's fine too.

These sessions are available throughout Nottinghamshire at a venue suitable for you.

County Education

If you want to brush up on your maths, English or computer skills, then Double Impact County Education could be for you.

We offer courses in all of the above and give you the chance to gain qualifications up to and including level 2.

We also offer Literacy Workshops to enable you to prepare for more structured courses leading up to a formal qualification.
